A. EVIDENCES, VIRTUES, AND IMPORTANCE OF NAMES OF ALLAAH AND OUR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1) "And to Allaah belong the best names, so invoke Him by them. And leave [the company of] those who practice deviation concerning His names. They will be recompensed for what they have been doing." [7: 180]
- 2) Abu Huraira reported: The Messenger of Allaah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Allaah has ninety-nine names and whoever preserves them will enter Paradise." [Ṣaḥīḥ al-Bukhārī 6597, Ṣaḥīḥ Muslim 2677].
- 3) Allama Ibne Qayyim Rahimahullah Says: "Leaning by heart", which is mentioned in the hadeeth, implies the following:
- 1. Memorising them
- 2. Understanding their meaning
- 3. Acting in accordance with the meanings.

So if a person knows that He is one, he does not associate anything else with Him. If he knows that He is the Provider (ar-Razzaaq), he does not seek provision from anyone other than Him. If he knows that He is Most Merciful (ar-Raheem), then he does acts of obedience and worship that are the means of attaining this mercy... and so on.

4. Calling upon Him by these names, as He, may He be glorified and exalted, says (interpretation of the meaning): "And (all) the Most Beautiful Names belong to Allaah, so call on Him by them' [al-A'raaf 7:180]. So he might say: O Most Merciful (Ya Rahmaan), have mercy on me; O Oft-forgiving (Ya Ghafoor), forgive me; O Accepter of repentance (Ya Tawwaab), accept my repentance, and so on.

B. PRINCIPLES, MAXIMS, AND

ETIQUETTES OF NAMES OF ALLAAH:

1) Ibne Abi Zayd Al Qayrawaani Says: "To Allaah belong all beautiful names and lofty attributes." [Muqaddimah Ibne Abi Zayd Al Qayrawaani Pg No. 82].

In its explanation Shaikh Abdul Muhsin Al Abbad Hafizahullah Writes:

- ➤ The names of Allaah can only be known through revelation (Quran and Sunnah) and it's not permissible for anyone to speak on this topic without knowledge.
- ➤ The Names of Allaah the All-Mighty and the Magnificent and His Characteristics (Sifaat) is that they affirm for Allaah –Azza wa Jal- what is affirmed in the Book and the Sunnah from the Names and Characteristics in the way which they befit Allaah Subhanahu Ta'ala- without explaining how they are, or resembling them with anything else, or with Tamtheel (to liken Allaah or His Characteristics to that of the creation), or Tahreef (alteration and distortion of wording or meaning), or Ta'weel (metaphorical interpretation) of them or cancelling them. Just as Allaah -Azza wa Jal- said: "There is nothing like unto Him and He is the All-Hearing the All-Seeing" [42:11]
- Allaah's names have been mentioned in Quran and they were declared as The Best names. "And to Allaah belong the best names, so invoke Him by them." [7:180]
- All of Allaah's Names are the best. This means that they all possess the highest extent of goodness and lofty status. They are not just good names rather they are the best names.
- So a Name is that which is considered a Name of Allaah (Subhaanahu wa Ta'aala), (and that) which incorporates an Attribute. And affirmation of a Name necessitates affirmation of an Attribute. For example: al-Azeez (the Almighty) is a Name, and (its affirmation) necessitates the (affirmation of the) Attribute of Izzah (Mightiness); Hakeem (All Wise) is a Name and (its affirmation) necessitates the affirmation of Hikmah

(Wisdom). Kareem (The Generous) is a Name and (its affirmation) necessitates the affirmation of Karam (Generosity). Lateef (The Most Gentle) is a Name and (its affirmation) necessitates the affirmation of Lutf (Gentleness). Azeem (The Magnificent) is a Name and (its affirmation) necessitates the affirmation of Azmah (Magnificence). Rehman and Raheem (The Entirely Merciful, the Especially Merciful) are Names and (its affirmation) necessitates the affirmation of Rehmah (Mercy). The same primciple applies for other names as well.

- ➤ No name of Allaah is a solitary noun. Some Scholars that Ad-Dahr (time) is one of the Names of Allaah but it's not.
- The Names of Allaah are not confined to a fixed and definite number. Allaah has taught some names to his creatures and appropriated some names for him in the knowledge of the Ghaib (Unseen).

This is based on the famous hadith: "I ask You, O Allaah, by every one of Your Names by which you have named yourself or revealed in Your Book. Or (those which you have) taught to one of your creatures or appropriated for yourself in the knowledge of the Ghaib (Unseen) that is with you." [Musnad Ahmed:3712,Ibne Hajar declared the chain of narration hasan(good) and Allama Albanee declared it authentic in silsilatul ahadees saheehah]

The way to combine between this hadith and the other authentic hadith: "Verily, to Allaah belong ninety-nine names, (by which) whosoever takes account of them (i.e. memorizes, learns and supplicates by them), will enter Paradise." [Bukhari: 7392, 2410, and 2736 and Sahih Muslim: 2677] It does not mean that Allaah's names are restricted to this number (of 99). This hadith indicates that the words "Allaah has ninety-nine names, whoever learns them will enter Paradise" mean that there are ninety-nine of His names which whoever learns them will enter Paradise. The equivalent of this would be if one were to say: "I have prepared one hundred books for students of knowledge for the purpose of teaching them." This does not negate that he has other books in his possession, which he has prepared for a purpose other than teaching.

- Some names of Allaah can also be used for the creation. "There has certainly come to you a Messenger from among yourselves. Grievous to him is what you suffer; [he is] concerned over you and to the believers is kind and merciful." [9:128] Here, Rauf and Raheem are used for the prophet sallelahu alayhi wa sallam but these names doesn't possess the same meaning when it is used for Allaah. There is no resemblance between the names(with its meanings) of creator and names of creation.
- Some names of Allaah can never be used for the creation. For Instance Rehman, Khaliq, Raziq, Samad, Baari etc...

C. AN ANALYSIS OF LIST OF ASMAUL HUSNA:

The famous hadith which was narrated by al-Tirmidhi(Hadith No.3507) via waleed bin muslim (May Allaah Reward Him), listing these ninety-nine names is a da'eef (weak) hadeeth for five reasons.

The chain of narration is Tafarrud(isolated), Shaaz(odd one out), Muztarib (that causing disturbance), Tadlees(Hiding the defects of an article being sold) And Mudraj(something entered into something else).

- Al-Tirmidhi (may Allaah have mercy on him) said, after narrating the hadith: This is a ghareeb hadith (i.e., it is weak, as is the apparent meaning of his words here).
- ➤ Ibne Hazm (may Allaah have mercy on him) said: No hadith listing all the names of Allaah is authentic.[Muhalla Ibne Hazm: 11/220]

According to the research of Shaikh Abdul Muhsin Al Abbad, Shaikh Alawi Abd al-Qadir al-Saqqaf, and Dr. Mahmood Abdur Razzaq Al Rizwaani (May Allaah Reward All of Them), There are 21 names in this list which are not proven from the quran and the sunnah. They are neither confined names nor unconfined names. Those 21 names are:

Note: We have learnt that is this famous list i.e. narration of the waleed ibne Muslim, there are 21 names which are not proven from the Quran and the sunnah. They are neither confined names nor unconfined names. There are 8 names in this list which are confined names which are not unconfined names.

D. THOSE NAMES WHICH SCHOLARS HAVE INCLUDED IN THE LIST OF ASMAUL HUSNA:

- According to Shaikh Alawi Abd al-Qadir al-Saqqaf (May Allaah Reward Him), Al Hafiz, Al Muheet And Al Hadee are names Of Allaah. [Refer to his book SifatAllaahi Azza Wa Jalla Al Warida Fee Kitaabi Wa Sunnah]
- According to Shaikh Khalifah At Taymee and Dr. Mahmood Abdur Razzaq Al Rizwaani (May Allaah Reward Both of Them), There are 8 names of Allaah which are confined names. They are not unconfined names. Those 8 names are: { Ar Rafi, Al Muhyi, Al Muntaqim, Al Jamiu, An Noor, Al Hadee, Al Badee and Zul Jalaali Wal Ikraam}. [Refer to their books Itiqaad Ahlus Sunnah Wal Jammah Fee Asmail Husna And Asmail Husna Fee Sabatihee Kitaabi Wa Sunnah respectively]
