



- The entire portion of the syllabus has to be completed within 8 months as per the above plan, from June to January of an academic year.
- February and March can be used as reserve time for absorbing holidays and extra curricular activities like competitions, school annual day, annual anjuman etc.
- ▶ Each Unit has to be completed within four weeks, and the subsequent two weeks are to be reserved for activities, exercises and exams etc, so that the lessons taught in the Unit are thoroughly memorised.
- ▶ Teachers are expected to do a preliminary study before teaching a particular lesson so that they implant the morals in the tender minds of the children in the light of Qur'an and Sunnah, so that they inculcate good manners, ethics and values right from childhood.
- > Students should be given different activities, like:
 - Pasting names and words on the thermocol sheets.
 - Pasting the supplications and Ahadith.
 - Colouring and decorating could be done.
 - Role-plays, skits etc. can be conducted.
- Arrange weekly public-speaking exercise sessions with the title "ANJUMAN TIME". Both listening and speaking help, therefore, have the students listen and speak alternatively.
- Have some participants say Qur'anic ayaat, others say Ahadith, few say Etiquettes, and some say Supplications; such that everyone gets to take part in every such anjuman weekly.
- It may be difficult to have every student participate every week, therefore it is advised to prepare a log, so that everyone gets equal opportunities.
- It is also strongly recommended to have every student say a lesson on the stage with in eight weeks.

AQEEDAH

Three Basic Principles of Deen

- 1) Recognition of "The Lord"
- 2) Recognition of "The Prophet"
- 3) Recognition of "The Religion"

It is essential for every human being to learn these three principles, because the success in the sight of Islam in this world and in the hereafter depends on how well one knows and acts upon these three principles.

The Messenger of Allaah said: whoever cheerfully accepts Allaah as his Lord, Islam as his religion and Muhammad as his Apostle is necessarily entitled to enter Paradise.

(Sahih Muslim: 1884)



Translation 3>

I am pleased with Allaah as my Lord, and with Islam as a Religion (a way of life), and with Muhammad as a Messenger. (Sahih Targheeb: 657)

It is compulsory to understand and act upon these three basic principles of Deen, to be guided on the straight path, to be saved from the punishment of the grave and to gain the pleasure of Allaah in the hereafter.







SEERAH

Lineage of Prophet & First Revelation

The name of our Prophet is MUHAMMAD , and His lineage is: Muhammad bin Abdullaah bin Abdul Muttalib bin Hashim.

MUHAMMAD significant is significant in the stribe of Quraish, and Quraish is highly respectable and noble clan of Arab. The Arabs are the descendants of the mighty Prophet Ismail bin Ibrahim

MUHAMMAD solved for 63 years, of which, 23 years were of His prophethood. When the Prophet turned 40, Allaah made him a Prophet and sent down the following as the first revelation:

اِقُراْ بِالْمِرَبِّكَ الَّذِي كَالَقَ خَلَقَ الْإِنْسَانَ مِنْ عَلَقَ. اِقْرَاُ وَرَبُّكَ الْآكُرُمُ الَّذِي عَلَّمَ بِالْقَلَمِ. عَلَّمَ الْإِنْسَانَ مَالَمُ يَعْلَمُ.

- 1) Recite in the name of your Lord who created
- 2) Created man from a clinging substance
- 3) Recite, and your Lord is the most Generous
- 4) Who taught by the pen
- 5} Taught man that which he knew not (Suratul Alaq 96: 1-5)

And then, after a gap, when the first few aayaat of Suratul Muddassir were revealed, He was commanded to set out for preaching and invite the people to the religion of Islam.

I heard Allaah's Messenger saying, 'Both legal and illegal things are evident but in between them there are doubtful, suspicious things and most of the people have no knowledge about them. So whoever saves himself from these suspicious things saves his Religion and his honor. (Sahih Bukhari: 52, Sahih Muslim: 1599)

Charity Brings Allaah's Blessings

Dear Children!

Today we will learn how charity brings Allaah's blessings

Abu Hurairah (May Allaah be pleased with him) said that Prophet Muhammad said:



While a person was in the wilderness he heard a voice from the cloud commanding it thus: Irrigate the garden of so and so. After that the clouds slinked aside and poured water on a stony ground. It filled a channel amongst the channels of that land and that person followed that water and he found a person standing in the garden busy in changing the course of water with the help of a hatchet.

He said to him: Servant of Allaah, what is your name? He said: So and so. And it was that very name which he had heard from the clouds. And he said to him: Servant of Allaah, why do you ask me my name? He said: I heard a voice from the clouds of which is the downpour, saying: Water the garden of so and so, like your name. What do you do for the favour shown to you by Allaah in this matter? He said: Now as you state so. I look what yield I get from it, and I give one-third as charity out of it and I and my children eat one-third of it and one-third I return to it as investment. (Sahih Muslim: 2984)

So children! From the above story we learnt that Allaah gives out of His bounty to the one who gives charity for the sake of Allaah from whatever Allaah has provided him.

Therefore, we should always be ahead in giving charity to the poor and the needy so that in-turn Allaah showers His mercy and blessings on us.

Fa A'oozubillaahi Minashshaitaa Nir rajeem Bismillaah Hir Rahmaan Nir Raheem




Respected faculty members and my dear brothers/sisters The topic of my talk is "TAWHEED"

The Arabic word Tawheed if translated in English means "Islamic Monotheism". Tawheed means to believe, to accept and to proclaim that 'Allaah is Alone' - in His Personality, in His Names, in His Attributes, in His Works and in all the acts of Worshipping Him. And there is no one to share the above 5 attributes with Allaah.

We believe that all the Prophets sent by Allaah from Adam ### to the last and final Messenger Muhammad 🚎 came with the common message of Tawheed i.e. inviting people to worship Allaah alone and forbidding from associating partners with Allaah as is mentioned in Suratun Nahl 16: 36 and Suratul Ambiya 21: 25





The biggest right Allaah has over His slaves is of Tawheed.

In a Hadith mentioned in Sahih Bukhari: 2856 and Sahih Muslim: 30 Mu'adh (May Allaah be pleased with him) narrates that the Prophet said: "The right that Allaah has over His slaves is that they worship Him alone, and that they associate no partner with Him"

Thus, whoever holds on to Tawheed is a dweller of Paradise, and whoever does the opposite of Tawheed is a dweller of Hellfire.

I pray to Allaah, to keep all of us firm on Tawheed, Aameen.

I conclude my talk with the Ayah of the Qur'an with which I started my talk from Suratul Ikhlaas 112: 1 - 4 in which Allaah says:

- 1} "Say, He is Allaah, [who is] One,
- 2) Allaah, the Eternal Refuge.
- 3) He neither begets nor is born,
- 4) Nor is there to Him any equivalent."

Wa Aakhiru da'waana Anilhamdulillaahi Rabbil Aalameen.

Description of Ablution (Wuzu)

- 1) Make the intention of wuzu in the heart, and start the wuzu by saying BISMILLAAH
- 2) Wash both the hands three times including the wrists.
- 3) Rinse your mouth three times, and rinse your nose three times.
- 4) Wash your face three times.
- 5} Wash your right hand, and then your left hand until the elbows, including the elbows three times.
- 6) Wiping the head with wet hands and then the ears, once each.
 - I) Description of Masah of the Head: Take both your wet palms from the front of your head to the back of it until the nape (not including the nape) wiping the head all along, and bring it back the same way until the front of the head.
 - II) Description of the Masah of the Ears: Wipe the inside of both the ears using the index fingers of both hands, and the outside of the ears with the thumbs.
- 7) Wash your right foot, and then your left foot three times both till the ankles including the ankles.
- 8) Proper care should be taken that every part is wet and not leave any part dry.





SEERAH

Life in Makkah & Hijrah



- Prophet Muhammad spent 13 years in Makkah inviting people to the worship of Allaah alone, and warned them against associating partners with Allaah.
- During the final period of His stay in Makkah, with the command of Allaah, Prophet was taken on a journey from Makkah to Baitul Maqdis in a single night. This journey is known as Al Israa (The Night of Journey)
- And then Allaah made the Prophet to travel from "Baitul Maqdis" to the seven skies, where Prophet was shown different scenes from the heaven and the hell, and this journey is called Al Me'raaj (The Ascend)
- The Prophet was gifted with the command of Farz Salaah (obligatory prayer) of five times a day during this journey of Al Me'raaj







- Initially, Prophet sand Sahaba sand used to offer Salaah hiding themselves from the Mushriks of Makkah.
- The Mushriks of Makkah harassed and troubled Prophet Muhammad ♣ and his companions continuously so much, that they even plotted to kill the Prophet ♣. Allaah protected the Prophet ♣ from them and commanded Him to migrate to the city of Madinah. This migration is called as Al-Hijrah.

Definition of Al-Hijrah: Leaving the place where Muslims cannot freely worship Allaah, for a place where they can freely worship Allaah is called Al-Hijrah (The Immigration).

Conditions of Wuzu

 To make the intention in the heart (Niyyah).

- 2) The water has to be clean.
 There are two types of water:
 - A) Clean Water: The rain water, spring, well, and the oceanic water, filtered and processed water.
 - B) Dirty Water: when something dirty falls into water, it becomes dirty changing its color, taste and/or odur.
- 3) All things/objects (ex: Nail polish) to be removed before wuzu which can prevent the parts of the body getting wet.

Note: If any of the above conditions is not fullfiled, wuzu becomes invalid.

Dear children! Allaah has mentioned moral stories of many Prophets in the Qur'an for us to take heed from. One such story is of Prophet Yusuf (May Allaah have mercy upon him). Allaah has revealed one whole Surah in the Qur'an with the name Yusuf



One night Yusuf was saw a dream that he saw eleven stars, sun and moon prostrating before him. When Yusuf told about his dream to his father Yaqoob was, he advised Yusuf not to disclose the dream to his brothers, as they may harm him out of jealousy.

Yusuf's father loved him so much. All the brothers of Yusuf said, why their father did love Yusuf more than them? Outraged with jealousy they all decided to take Yusuf was away from home and kill him or leave him in a well, so that they can be loved by their father.

Finally Yusuf's brothers took him away from home and put him in an empty well, where there was no food and water. In the evening they returned with a blood stained shirt and lied to their father that Yusuf had been attacked by a wolf.

On the other side Allaah saved Yusuf and informed him that there will be a day, when Yusuf will be a noble personality and he will inform his brothers of what they have done with him.

Dear children! From the story of Yusuf we learnt that jealousy is wickedness and it motivates you to do sins and wrong things even to the extent of harming friends and relatives.

Jealousy is the attribute of Satan and we should keep away from it.

Therefore, we can derive that the real saving is not what we eat and store in our homes but the real saving is what we spend in the way of Allaah for His pleasure.

I took hold of him and said, "By Allaah, I will take you to Allaah's Messenger ..." He said, "I am needy and have many dependents, and I am in great need."I released him, and in the morning Allaah's Messenger asked me, "What did your prisoner do yesterday?" I said, "O Allaah's Messenger ! The person complained of being needy and of having many dependents, so, I pitied him and let him go." Allaah's Messenger said, "Indeed, he told you a lie and he will be coming again."

I believed that he would show up again as Allaah's Messenger had told me that he would return. So, I waited for him watchfully. When he (showed up and) started stealing handfuls of foodstuff, I caught hold of him again and said, "I will definitely take you to Allaah's Messenger . He said, "Leave me, for I am very needy and have many dependents. I promise I will not come back again." I pitied him and let him go.

In the morning Allaah's Messenger asked me, "What did your prisoner do." I replied, "O Allaah's Messenger ! He complained of his great need and of too many dependents, so I took pity on him and set him free." Allaah's Apostle said, "Verily, he told you a lie and he will return."



I waited for him attentively for the third time, and when he (came and) started stealing handfuls of the foodstuff, I caught hold of him and said, "I will surely take you to Allaah's Messenger as it is the third time you promise not to return, yet you broke your promise and came." He said, "(Forgive me and) I will teach you some words with which Allaah will benefit you." I asked, "What are they?" He replied, "Whenever you go to bed, recite "Aayat-ul-Kursi"- 'Allaahu Laa ilaaha illa huwal Hayyul Qayyum' till you finish the whole Ayat. (If you do so), Allaah will appoint a guard for you who will stay with you and no Satan will come near you till morning. "So, I released him.

In the morning, Allaah's Apostle asked, "What did your prisoner do yesterday?" I replied, "He claimed that he would teach me some words by which Allaah will benefit me, so I let him go." Allaah's Messenger asked, "What are they?" I replied, "He said to me, 'Whenever you go to bed, recite from the beginning to the end Aayat-ul-Kursi--'Allaahu Laa ilaaha illa huwal Hayyul Qayyum'--.' He further said to me, '(If you do so), Allaah will appoint a guard for you who will stay with you, and no Satan will come near you till morning.' The companions were very keen to do good deeds. The Prophet said, "He really spoke the truth, although he is an absolute liar. Do you know whom you were talking to, these three nights, O Abu Hurairah?" Abu Hurairah said, "No." He said, "It was Satan."

Dear Children! From the above Hadith we learnt that we should read Aayatul Kursi every day before sleeping so that Allaah will protect us from Satan, In-Shaa-Allaah.


